The European Veterans Championship in Sweden saw a magnificent win for Surrey player Ramesh Bhalla who beat Finland's Kai Merimaa 3-1 in the Final of the Men's Singles Over 80's to win Gold.

At the Jarvis Sports Horsham Spinners TTC 2 star Robert Pelc was Runner-up in the under-18's, and won the Bronze medal in the under-15's. Nahom Goitom was Runner-up in the under -14's event.
